

## **Precautions**

### Installation

### Do not install the unit where:

- it is exposed to direct sunlight or air-conditioning vent,
- near heating equipment,
- the temperature is lower than 10°C (50°F) or it is subject to sudden temperature change.

## Handling


- Do not touch the screen, or erase it while it is moving.
- Do not leave writing on the screen for long periods of time.

### Marker, eraser and copy paper

- Use only the included or designated marker, eraser and copy paper. (See "Specifications" on back cover.)
- Store a copy paper roll in a cool, dark, moisture free location.
- Do not store printed copies exposed to direct sunlight or high humidity, or inside vinyl chloride (plastic) files.
- For long-term storage, make another copy with an ordinary paper copier machine.

### Film screen

- Write with bold, dark strokes [over 1 mm (1/32")].
- The shaded areas are not copied.



## Loading the copy paper

Make sure the power switch is on

1 Press "PUSH OPEN" and open the door (Fig 1)

2 (1) Load the copy paper roll (Fig 2)



(2) Pass the paper over the feed roller and under the paper guide, then through the printer slot about 4 cm (1½ inches) (Fig 3)


Note To load 100 m roll [Diameter  $\cdot$  about 94 mm (3  $^{11}/_{18}$  inches)

- (1) Open until position B and load it, then back it to position A to prevent paper roll drop (Fig. 4)
- (2) Set the paper according to Item 2-2

3 Close the printer door securely, using two hands
Note Once the door is closed, paper will feed and
automatically cut Remove and discard the
small piece of paper


#### Load a new roll when:

- Red bands become visible at the edge of the copy paper
- The ERROR indicator "P" goes on and off even after the printer door is closed properly



# Operation (To make copies)

Panasonic KX-8420



#### Caution

- Use AC 120V, 60Hz only
- Use the power cord, included
- Do not damage the power cord
- Remove the plug by holding it not by pulling the cord
- Do not touch the plug with wet hand
- To copy charts, graphs, etc.

  Affix it to the screen with drafting tape made by 3M® or other similar tape with medium adhesive

Turn the power switch on by pressing the " | " side of the "power"

Note If the screen is not in "home" position, the screen will move to home position and stop

- When the ERROR Indicator shows "0" to "1", it is ready for copy
   Confirm the ERROR Indicator "P" is off
- Confirm the ERROR Indicator "P" is off (If not, refer to 'Loading the copy paper")
- When not in use, be sure to turn the power off
- Press the Copy Key to start the copy process
  Copied paper Holder can hold up to 10 copies
  Note
  - Do not hold 11 copies or more, otherwise the paper may jam.
  - While copying, do not touch the paper, otherwise the paper may jam
- ■To advance to the next screen

Press the ADVANCE key 🔻 to go to the next screen

# **Troubleshooting**

Symptom	Care and remedy	
Power won't turn on	Confirm the power plug is securely connected	
No copy paper emerges after the COPY Key is pressed	Paper is exhausted (ERROR indicator "P" goes on and off) →Load new paper (See p. 2)	
	Printer door opens (ERROR indicator "P" goes on and off)  →Close the door gently until a click is heard	
	Paper is jammed  Remove the jammed paper and cut off the wrinkled portion, load paper again	
Nothing is printed on the paper	Confirm the paper is loaded correctly, smooth side face up (See p. 2)	
Copies are faint or blurred	Your writing is too thin or faint →Write with thicker, darker strokes, or use a new marker	
	Printer door is slightly open  —Close the door gently until a click is heard	
Poorly defined stripes or unwanted lines appear on the copy	The printer head is dirty →Open the printer door and clean the printer head (See p 2 and 5)	
Black lines appear on the copy	The room temperature is 10°C (50°F) or lower	
The screen doesn't advance when the COPY or ADVANCE Key is pressed	Static electricity is generated when cleaning  Turn off the power and move the screen gently by hand	
Large amount of ink dust remains on the film screen	Clean the screen (See p 5) After cleaning, turn on the power switch once	
Power switch is on but the indicator is off	Turn off the power switch and then on again


Indication	Cause	Remedy
171	No paper	Load the copy paper roll
j-`	Printer door is not closed securely	Close the door securely
]_	Printer can not cut the paper	Open the printer door and clear the jammed paper
	Screen does not move	Try to move the screen by hand, remove any charts taped to screen
	The room temperature is 10°C (50°F) or lower	Raise the room temperature
<u></u>	The fluorescent lamp is dead	Call your dealer for service



# **Troubleshooting**

### ■To release jammed paper

- 1 Open the printer door
- Remove the jammed paper by pulling the paper roll to the direction A. If the jammed paper is still in the cutter cover, remove it using tweezers from slot B.
- 3 Cut the paper as shown in Fig. 1
- In case the paper cannot go through, just put the paper on the paper feed roller as shown Fig. 2
- 5 Close the printer door





# Care and cleaning

Be sure to turn off the power and unplug the power plug before cleaning

### Cleaning the film screen and the unit body


- Wipe gently with a soft cloth, which has been dipped in water and wrung out thoroughly
- Never use thinner benzine or detergent containing abrasives
- Never wipe the screen with a dry cloth, since this may cause static electricity

For hard stains, use a small amount of household detergent dissolved in water For accidental writing with an oil marker, use a small amount of ethyl alcohol Ensure that there is good ventilation



#### Cleaning the print head

- Wipe gently with a cotton swab-dipped in ethyl alcohol
- Never touch the printer head and its surrounding area with your fingers



#### Cleaning the eraser

When the eraser becomes blackened with ink, remove the wiping portion as illustrated below, wash well with household detergent, then dry thoroughly in an area away from sunlight
